- Participants will work alongside native Hawaiian water hydrologists, marine biologists, and cultural practitioners and learn how they integrate Hawaiian cultural values into their careers.
- Participants will work with specialists to collect data through water testing, fish and limu population count, fish survey and monitoring, stream monitoring, KILO – observation of the natural environment, and remove, sort and recycle plastic marine debris.
- Participants will work with land restoration experts to work in the taro patches, clear overgrowth, identify native plants, identify native sea birds.
- Cultural classes will include, but not limited to, lauhala weaving, la'au lapa'au (native medicinal plants), lomilomi, makahiki games, coconut leaf weaving, and lei-making.
